Make sure the main breaker is turned off. Installation must be carried out by a qualified person in accordance with applicable standards in the country concerned.


















ADAPTER (MODEL 3492-3494)



9,1B) Connect to external battery box. Install battery box on backplate bracket in the lower storage space. Tighten using the butterfly nut.























REPLACEMENT OF BATTERIES AND PUMP









PRODUCT APPLICATION

- Place hands approx 2-10 cm under the sensor to activate the dispenser. The dispenser will release 1-1.2 ml. disinfectant gel
- · Move hands away after disinfectant release
- · Stops automatically when hands are moved away

IMPORTANT!

- Ensure easy access to cleaning and maintenance of the product
- Do not bend the plastic tube too sharp. It will cause reduced dosage or total block total blockage in ture
- · Ensure the unit is placed on a firm and stable base

LIGHT INDICATOR (ADAPTER)

Standby	Red light
Active	Green light
Obstruction of sensor	Flashing green and red light

LIGHT INDICATOR (BATTERIES)

Standby	No light
Active	Green light
Obstruction of sensor	Flashing green and red light

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Routine cleaning and maintenance is recommended

REPLACEMENT OF DISINFECTANT BOTTLE

- · Use the key supplied to open the door
- · Remove empty bottle from the rack
- · Replace with new bottle
- · Insert pump tube into the bottle
- · Close the door

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE OF CONTROL BOX

- · Cut the power
- · Remove any dust and dirt
- · Do not rinse with running water
- Use a damp cloth and mild cleaning solution. Never use cleaning detergents with an abrasive effect

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE OF TAP/SENSOR


- · Do not rinse with running water
- Use a damp cloth and mild cleaning solution. Never use cleaning detergents with an abrasive effect
- · Clean sensor for dust and dirt to prevent unintentional activation

TROUBLESHOOTING AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

SYMPTOM	POTENTIAL CAUSE	CORRECTIVE ACTION
No disinfectant is delivered	Low supply	Refill the disinfectant bottle
	Sensor window is dirty	Clean the sensor window
	Obstruction in front of the sensor window	Remove the obstruction
	Damaged sensor	Contact DAN DRYER for advice
	Tube disconnected from pump	If the end of the tube is damaged, please remove the damaged part. The undamaged tube is to be mounted on the nozzle exit of the pump
	Sensor cabling disconnected from control box	Check that the cable from the faucet is installed correctly in the control box
	Power supply has been disconnected	Check that the cable from the adapter or the external battery box is installed correctly in the control box (see page 7)
	AC/DC adapter not connected	Check that the AC/DC adapter is plugged into the wall and is getting power
The dispenser activates unintentionally	Sensor window is dirty	Clean the sensor window
	Obstruction in front of the sensor window	Remove the obstruction
	Damaged sensor	Contact DAN DRYER for advice
